## CORRESPONDENT POSITION

*High Plains Journal* is seeking a correspondent who is working on a custom harvesting crew for the 2010 wheat harvest to help us:

- Document harvest progress and report important news
- Capture the unique people and places along the way
- Illustrate what an exciting event that harvest is in America's Heartland.

### Skills needed:

1. Ability to “speak wheat.” Correspondents should be able to relate the important aspects of wheat harvest that other farmers and harvesters would be interested in (yields, crop conditions, diseases, weeds, weather conditions, equipment)
2. Good writing and communication skills. Correspondents will be writing a “journal” of their experiences during the 2010 season including crop and weather conditions, but also human interest aspects of the summer.
3. Photography and/or video skills. Correspondents will share the beauty of America's Heartland through photos and/or video.
4. Attention to detail including grammar and spelling.
5. Knowledge of blogging, Twitter and other digital media preferred.

**Methods:** The All Aboard 2010 Wheat Harvest coverage will be done in a variety of formats including: a blog (Posting should be done on average one time per day), a weekly update in print in *High Plains Journal*, and a summer-end wrap up special section inserted in *High Plains Journal*. The weekly updates and the summer-end wrap-up will be gleaned by *High Plains Journal* editors from the blog posted by the correspondent.

Correspondents should already be a part of a harvest crew and interested in sharing their experiences with *High Plains Journal* print and online readers. Permission must be granted by the owner of the harvest crew.

**Equipment:** Correspondents will need a laptop computer, cell phone, internet access, and a digital camera with video capabilities, which will be provided for them if needed.

**Time requirements:** Coverage should be throughout the time when the crew is harvesting through the *High Plains Journal* coverage area.

**Compensation:** Correspondents will be paid with a \$3,000 scholarship or stipend.
